

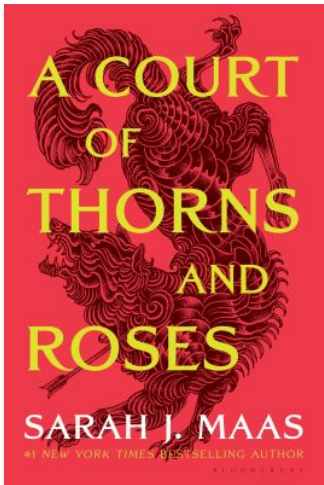


Books You Can't Put Down

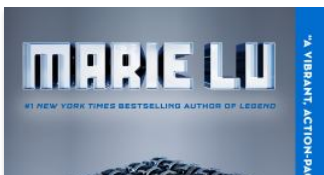


A court of thorns and roses

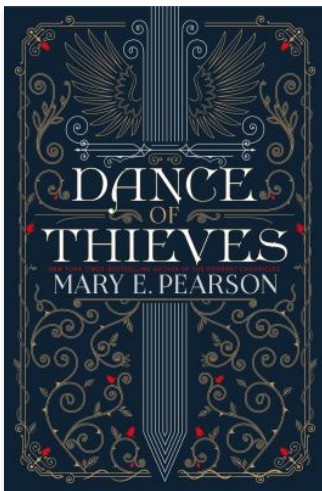

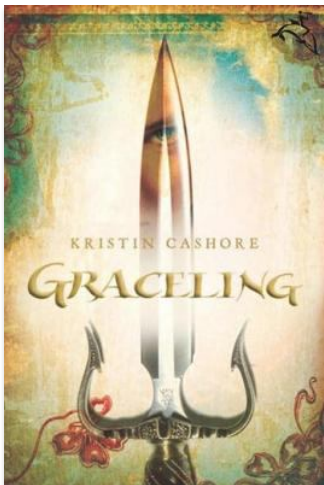

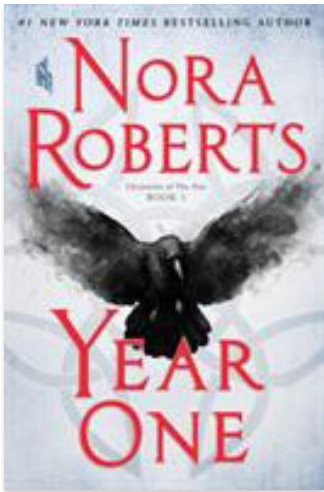
